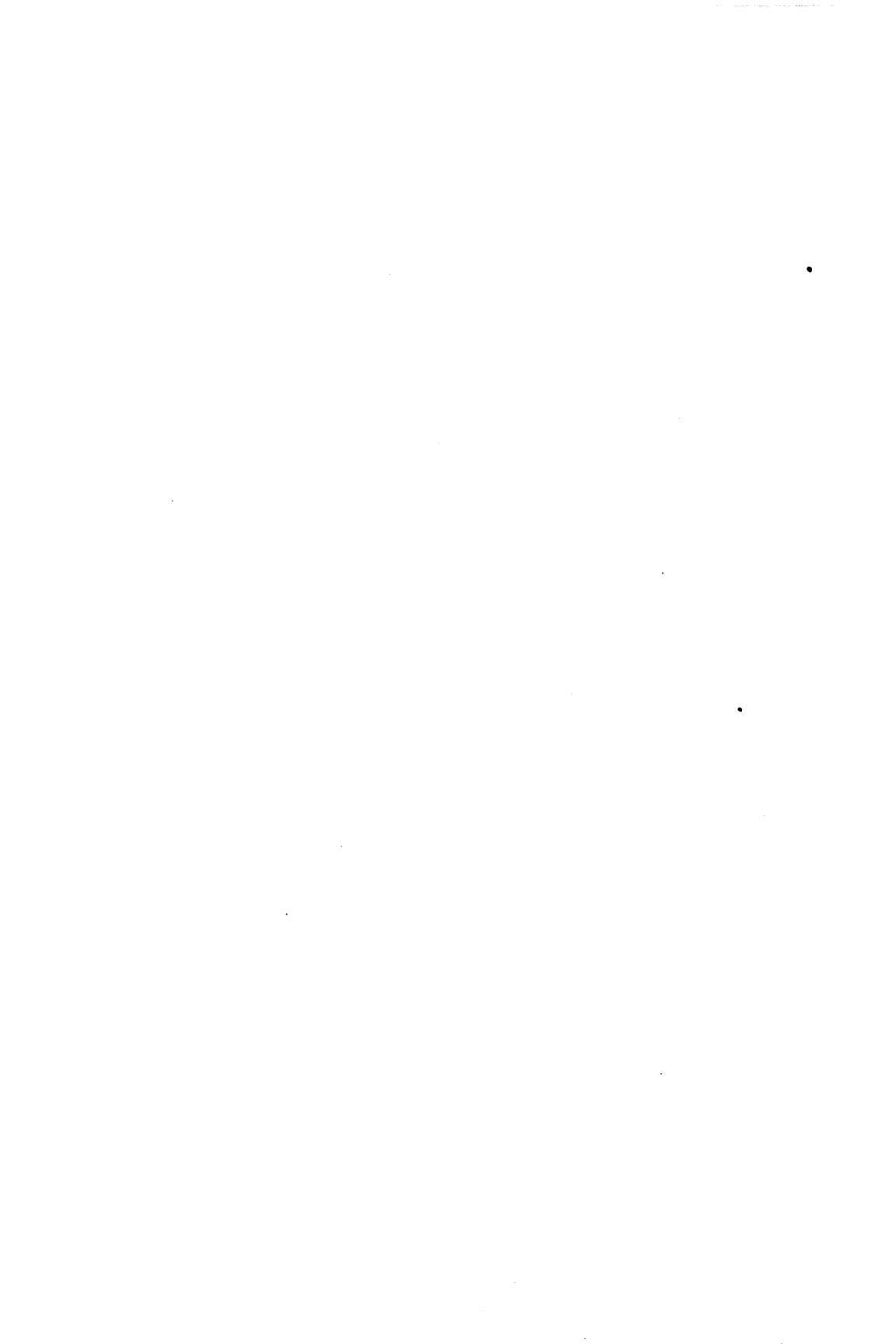
AN ACT to correct an error, and repeal an act approved February 11, 1903, relating to migratory fish.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. An act entitled an act to amend section seven-
2 teen of chapter forty of the Revised Statutes, as amended by
3 chapter two hundred and sixty-one of the Public Laws of
4 1885, and by chapter sixty-one of the Public Laws of 1891,
5 relating to migratory fish, approved February eleventh, 1903,
6 is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts which were expressly or
2 impliedly repealed by the said act of February 11, 1903, are
3 hereby revived and re-enacted.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
