STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to construe and continue in force chapter one hundred and six of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, relating to the election of a school committee, and superintendent of schools, for the town of Skowhegan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter 106 of the Private and Special Laws of the year
2 1891 is hereby re-enacted, and shall be construed to authorize
3 the town of Skowhegan to act either under the provisions
4 thereof or according to the general statutes, and to change
5 from one method to the other, at any annual meeting, pro-
6 vided the warrant contains a proper article for that purpose.
