STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter ninety-three of the
Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, fixing the
salary of the County Commissioners of Kennebec County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter ninety-three of the
2 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, is hereby
3 amended, by striking out the words "eighteen hundred and
4 eighty-nine" in the second line thereof, and inserting in place
5 thereof the words 'nineteen hundred and three'; also by strik-
6 ing out in the fourth line the words "two dollars and fifty
7 cents" and inserting in place thereof the words 'three dol-
8 lars,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January, in the
10 year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, the
11 salary of each of the county commissioners for the county
12 of Kennebec, shall be three dollars per day, instead of the
13 sum now fixed by law, while actually employed in the service
14 of the county, including the time spent in traveling, for which
15 he shall have ten cents a mile for the distance actually
16 traveled.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
