STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to regulate the appointment of Constables by the City
Council of Portland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The city council of the city of Portland may, at
2 the time of the election of subordinate city officers, or as soon
3 thereafter as may be, elect not exceeding nine city constables
4 and their term of office shall be for one year and until others
5 are qualified in their place.

Sect. 2. The provisions of section one shall not be con-
2 strued as repealing or amending the provisions of sections
3 twelve and thirteen of chapter two hundred and seventy-five
4 of the Special Laws of 1863, entitled "An Act to confer cer-
5 tain powers on the city of Portland."

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
