IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT authorizing the town of Fort Fairfield to make a loan.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Fort Fairfield  
2 are hereby authorized to procure by loan on the faith and  
3 credit of the town a sum of money not exceeding thirty thou-  
4 sand dollars for the purpose of erecting, equipping and fur-  
5 nishing a school building; and they may issue bonds therefor  
6 on such terms and conditions as the town shall vote.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
