STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT in relation to the discharge of debtors in cases
now pending in insolvent courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. A discharge shall not be granted to a debtor
2 in any case now pending in the several insolvent courts of
3 this state unless written application is made therefor to the
4 judge before the first day of January, nineteen hundred and
5 four, and in case no such application is made, all proceed-
6 ings in such case may be dismissed upon motion of any

7 party interested, after such notice, if any, as the judge shall
8 order.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
