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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to incorporate the Village Cemetery Association of  
Searsport, Waldo county, Maine.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Cyrus True, J. W. Black, E. Hopkins, J. A.  
2 Colson and L. M. Sargent, their associates, successors and  
3 assigns, are hereby made a corporation by the name of the  
4 Village Cemetery Association, for the purpose of enlarging,  
5 improving and caring for the Village cemetery, so called, in  
6 the town of Searsport.

Sect. 2. Said association shall have power to purchase land,  
2 to enlarge and improve said cemetery, to lay out lots and to  
3 sell the same, to receive and hold trust funds for the care or  
4 improvement of said cemetery or any part thereof.

Sect. 3. The officers of said association shall be a president,  
2 vice president, secretary, treasurer and superintendent. The  
3 president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and superin-  
4 tendent, together with three or more members of the asso-  
5 ciation who shall be elected by the association, shall consti-  
6 tute the executive committee. Said executive committee  
7 shall have full control of all work and improvements, the  
8 laying out of all moneys and the investment of all trust funds  
9 of the association.

Sect. 4. Regular meetings of said association for the choice  
2 of officers and the transaction of any business that may  
3 legally come before said meetings shall be held annually on  
4 the first Saturday in May. Officers so chosen shall hold office  
5 for the term of one year or until their successors are elected.

Sect. 5. The first meeting of said corporation shall be called  
2 by written notice thereof, signed by any two corporators  
3 herein named, served upon each corporator, by giving him  
4 the same in hand, or by leaving same at his last usual place of  
5 abode, seven days before the time of said meeting.
