IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Number Nine lake, situated  
in Township 9, Range 3, in the county of Aroostook.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill, in any  
2 way, any fish in Number Nine lake, situated in Township 9,  
3 Range 3, in the county of Aroostook, from October first to  
4 June first of each year, under a penalty of not less than ten  
5 dollars nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense,  
6 and one dollar additional for each fish caught, taken or killed  
7 in violation of this act.
