STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Number Nine lake, situated in Township 9, Range 3, in the county of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill, in any

- 2 way, any fish in Number Nine lake, situated in Township 9,
- 3 Range 3, in the county of Aroostook, from October first to
- 4 June first of each year, under a penalty of not less than ten
- 5 dollars nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense,
- 6 and one dollar additional for each fish caught, taken or killed
- 7 in violation of this act.
