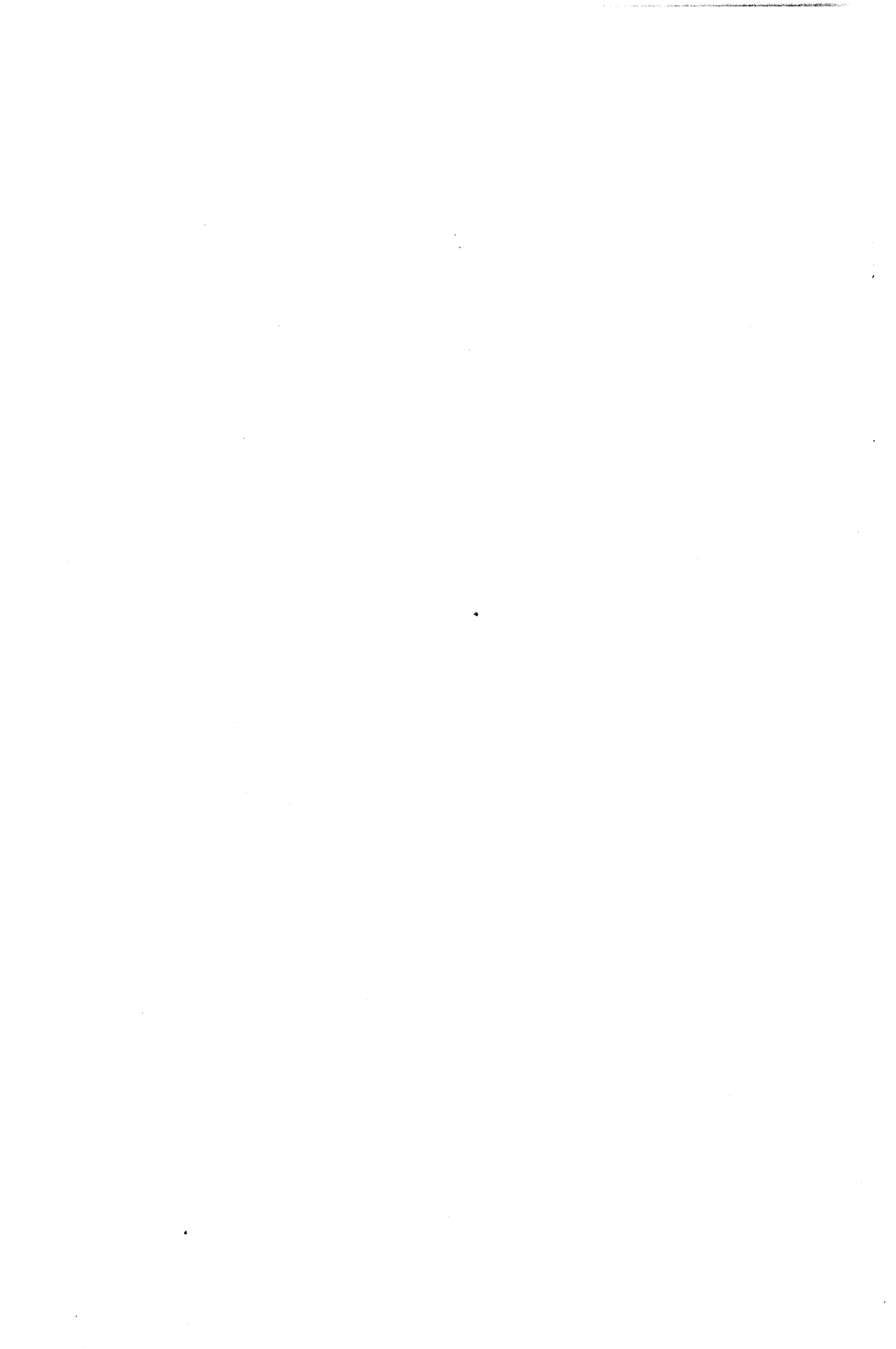
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of sawdust and other refuse matter into Half Moon stream or Sandy stream or any of the tributaries to Unity pond, in the county of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to put, or
2 allow the same to be done by any person within his employ,
3 any sawdust, slabs, edgings, or other refuse matter into Half
4 Moon stream or Sandy stream or any of the tributaries to
5 Unity pond, in the county of Waldo, under a penalty of not
6 less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars and costs
7 for each offense.
