STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT opening certain tributaries to Sebec lake to fishing
under the general law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish for, take, catch and kill
2 fish, in accordance with the general law of the State, in all of
3 the streams flowing into Sebec lake, in Piscataquis county,
4 except Wilson stream and Ship pond stream.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
