HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to change time of holding sessions of county commis-  
sioners in Aroostook county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section six, chapter seventy-eight of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended, so far as it relates to holding  
3 annual sessions of the county commissioners in the county of  
4 Aroostook, so that that part of said section shall read as fol-  
5 lows: 'Aroostook, on the first Tuesdays of January, March,  
6 May, July, September and November.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
