IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Portage Lake Mill Company to build
and maintain Piers and Booms and to operate a Steamboat in
Portage lake.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The Portage Lake Mill Company is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to build, maintain and control piers, booms and
3 hitching posts in the southerly end of Portage lake in the
4 county of Aroostook, opposite land owned by said company
5 and the adjoining lands, to enable said company to hold and
6 retain logs and lumber to be manufactured at the mill of said
7 company, in Portage Lake plantation, in said county of Aroos-

8 took, but said piers and booms shall be so constructed as not
9 to interfere with or obstruct the landing or channel leading
10 to said landing on the State road, so called; and said com-
11 pany is hereby also authorized and empowered to own and
12 operate a boat, propelled by steam or other power, to tow
13 logs across said lake and for other purposes, in said Portage
14 lake.

THEORY
