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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to repeal sections one to forty-seven, inclusive, and sections forty-nine to eighty-two, inclusive of chapter forty-seven of the Revised Statutes relating to banks of discount.

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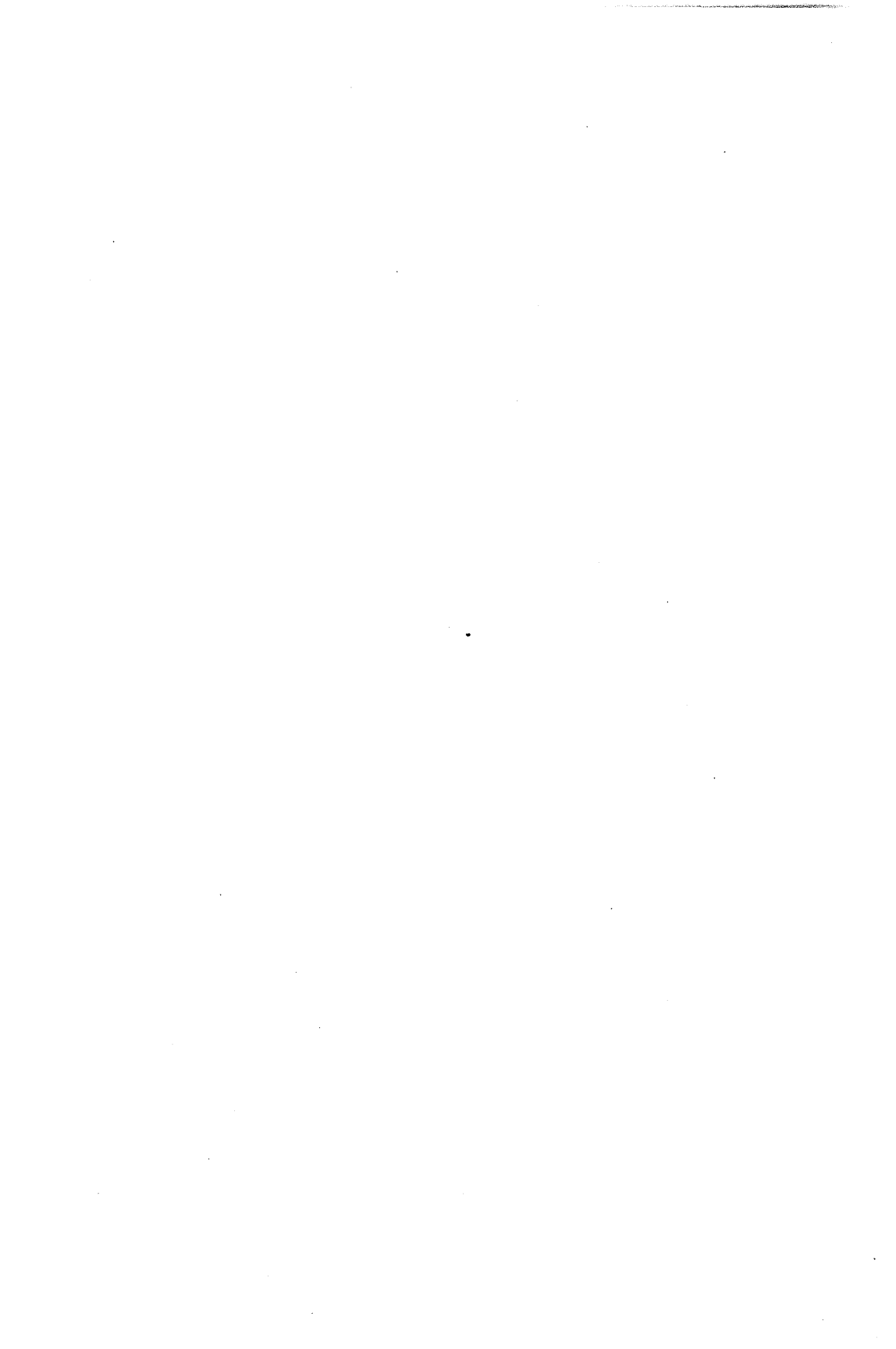
*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Sections one to forty-seven, both inclusive, and 2 sections forty-nine to eighty-two, both inclusive, of chapter 3 forty-seven of the Revised Statutes are hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. The sections declared to be repealed in the fore- 2 going section remain in force for the trial and punishment of 3 all past violations of them; and for the recovery of penalties 4 or forfeitures already incurred; and for the preservation of 5 all rights and their remedies existing by virtue of them; and 6 so far as they apply to any office, trust, judicial proceeding, 7 right, contract, limitation or event already affected by them.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
