STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to increase and fix the salary of the Assistant Librarian.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The State librarian shall appoint one assistant
2 who shall perform the duties prescribed by him, and shall
3 give bond to the librarian for the faithful performance of the
4 same. The assistant librarian shall receive a salary of twelve
5 hundred dollars, per year, beginning January one, nineteen
6 hundred and three, in full for all his services of every name
7 and nature.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act,
2 are hereby repealed. This act shall take effect when approved.
