STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to permit the use of purse seines in Damariscotta river.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The use of purse seines in Damariscotta river,
2 for the purpose of catching all fish except smelts and alewives,
3 from the mouth of said river to a point known as the "Ledges"
4 is hereby permitted and made legal from the first day of July
5 to the first day of November, inclusive, in each year.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 law are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
