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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section forty-four of chapter two of the  
Revised Statutes, relating to the publication of the Public  
Laws.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section forty-four of chapter two of the Revised  
2 Statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking  
3 out the words "one dollar" in the fifth line and inserting in  
4 place thereof the words 'two dollars,' so that said section as  
5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 44. He shall cause the Public Laws passed at each  
7 session to be printed within thirty days after the close thereof  
8 on extra sheets, on good paper, in good clear nonpareil type,

9 by the publishers of each newspaper; and each printer who  
10 so publishes and distributes the laws to his subscribers within  
11 the State, shall receive ten dollars, besides two dollars for  
12 every hundred copies so distributed within the State.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
