STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of sawdust and other mill waste into all tributaries of Seven Tree pond and Crawford pond in Union and Warren.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person or persons shall put, or allow the
- 2 same to be done by any person within his employ, any saw-
- 3 dust, shavings, bark, or other mill waste, into any of the
- 4 tributaries of Seven Tree pond, in Union, in the county of
- 5 Knox, or in any of the tributaries of Crawford pond, in
- 6 Union and Warren, in said Knox county, or place or deposit
- 7 such mill waste, or other refuse, along the banks in such a

8 manner that the same shall fall or be washed into said brooks 9 or streams.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the provisions of section one 2 of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five 3 dollars and not more than fifty dollars and costs for each 4 offense.
