In Senate, January 4, 1905.

Ordered, The House concurring, that the Joint Rules and

- 2 Orders of 1903-1904 be adopted as the Joint Rules and
- 3 Orders of this legislature, with the following amendments:

In Rule 1, strike out the word "telegraphs," from the line

- 5 "railroads, telegraphs and expresses," so that the same shall
- 6 read 'railroads and expresses.'

Immediately following, insert line, 'on telegraphs and tele-8 phones.'

Strike out the words, "public charities and State benefi-10 ciaries." and substitute therefor the words, 'insane hospitals.'

Strike out the words, "reform school," and substitute there-12 for the words, 'State school for boys.'

Strike out Rule 18, and substitute therefor the following:

- '18. Every act, resolve or order, appropriating money,
- 15 shall be referred to the appropriate committee for considera-
- 16 tion, and no further action shall be had thereon in either
- 17 branch until the same shall have been reported back by said
- 18 committee.'
