## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the Winthrop and Wayne Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of the Winthrop and Wayne 2 Light and Power Company, under the general laws of the 3 State, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Permission is hereby given to said company, to
2 exercise its corporate powers of making, generating, selling,
3 distributing and supplying gas and electricity for lighting,
4 heating, manufacturing and mechanical purposes in the towns
5 of Winthrop, Monmouth, Wayne and Readfield in the county
6 of Kennebec.

Sect. 3. The action of the selectmen of the town of Win-2 throp, and the action of the selectmen of the town of Wayne,

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3 in granting to said company permits to construct its lines
4 upon and along the highways and public roads in said towns,
5 is hereby ratified and confirmed. Said permits were granted
6 as follows: by the selectmen of Wayne, August 22, 1904,
7 and by the selectmen of Winthrop, September 13, 1904.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
