AN ACT to validate and legalize the organization of Muscle  
Ridge Plantation.

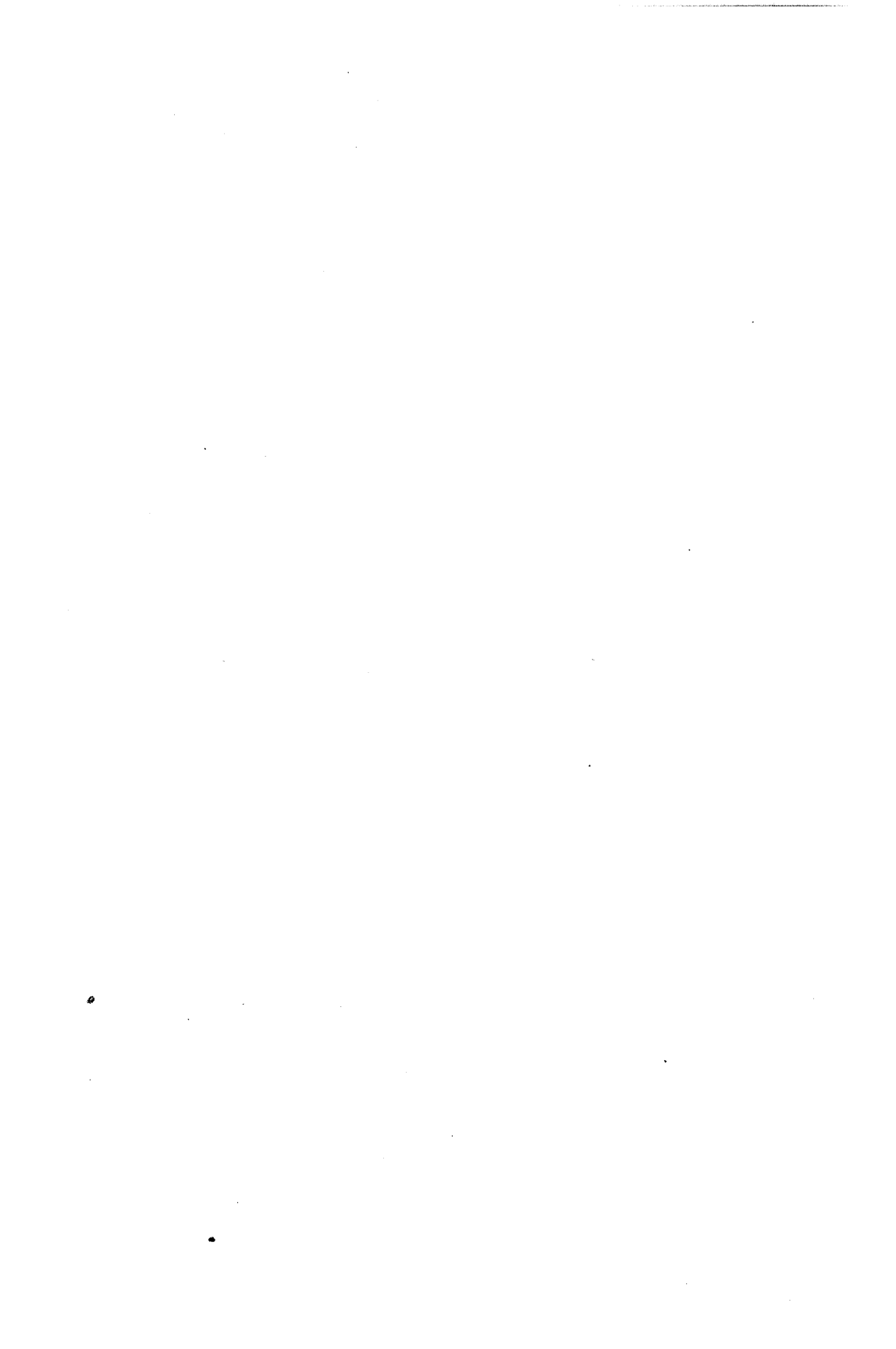

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The incorporation and organization of Muscle  
2 Ridge plantation, as organized at a meeting of said plantation  
3 held on the 28th day of October, A. D. 1904, in accordance  
4 with the return made to the secretary of State on said 28th  
5 day of October, and received by him October 31, 1904, is  
6 hereby declared to be and is made the legal and valid organ-  
7 ization of the territory therein described, and said territory  
8 is thereby organized as, and constituted a plantation in  
9 accordance with the votes passed at said meeting, and entitled  
10 to all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the liabili-

11 ties of plantations organized under section 115, chapter 4  
12 and the following sections of the Revised Statutes, and the  
13 acts done by said plantation are hereby ratified and declared  
14 valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
