STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Camden and Rockland Water Company to issue bonds for the purpose of retiring certain of its outstanding bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section 1. The Camden and Rockland Water Company is
2 hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds to pay,
3 retire and cancel certain of its outstanding bonds and any
4 mortgage or mortgages securing the same, and for the
5 further construction and improvement of its works, for such
6 amount and upon such rate and time as it may deem expe-
7 dient, not to exceed the sum of two hundred and fifty thou-
8 sand dollars; and to secure the same by mortgage or deed
9 of trust of all or any part of its franchise, property, rights
10 and privileges, now owned by it or to be hereafter acquired.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
