RESOLVE appropriating money for the support of Traveling
Libraries.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars be
2 and is hereby appropriated for the maintenance of traveling
3 libraries for the year nineteen hundred and five, and that
4 a like sum be and is hereby appropriated for the support of
5 said libraries for nineteen hundred and six, the same to be
6 expended under the direction of the library commission with
7 the approval of the governor and council.
