IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relative to the Winter Harbor Gas and Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Winter Harbor Gas and Light Company, 2 a corporation organized and existing under the general laws 3 of the State of Maine, is hereby authorized and empowered 4 to make, generate, sell, distribute and supply gas or elec-5 tricity, or both for lighting, heating, manufacturing or 6 mechanical purposes in the town of Winter Harbor and 7 adjoining town of Guldsboro, in the county of Hancock.

Sect. 2. The inhabitants of the towns of Winter Harbor 2 and Gouldsboro are hereby authorized to contract with said 3 company for lighting said towns for such time and upon such

4 terms as they may by vote or authority of the selectmen 5 determine.

Sect. 3. The Winter Harbor Company, a corporation 2 established and existing under the laws of said State, is 3 hereby authorized and empowered to become a stockholder 4 in the Winter Harbor Gas and Light Company with all the 5 privileges, rights, powers and liabilities of stockholders.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
