Franklin.

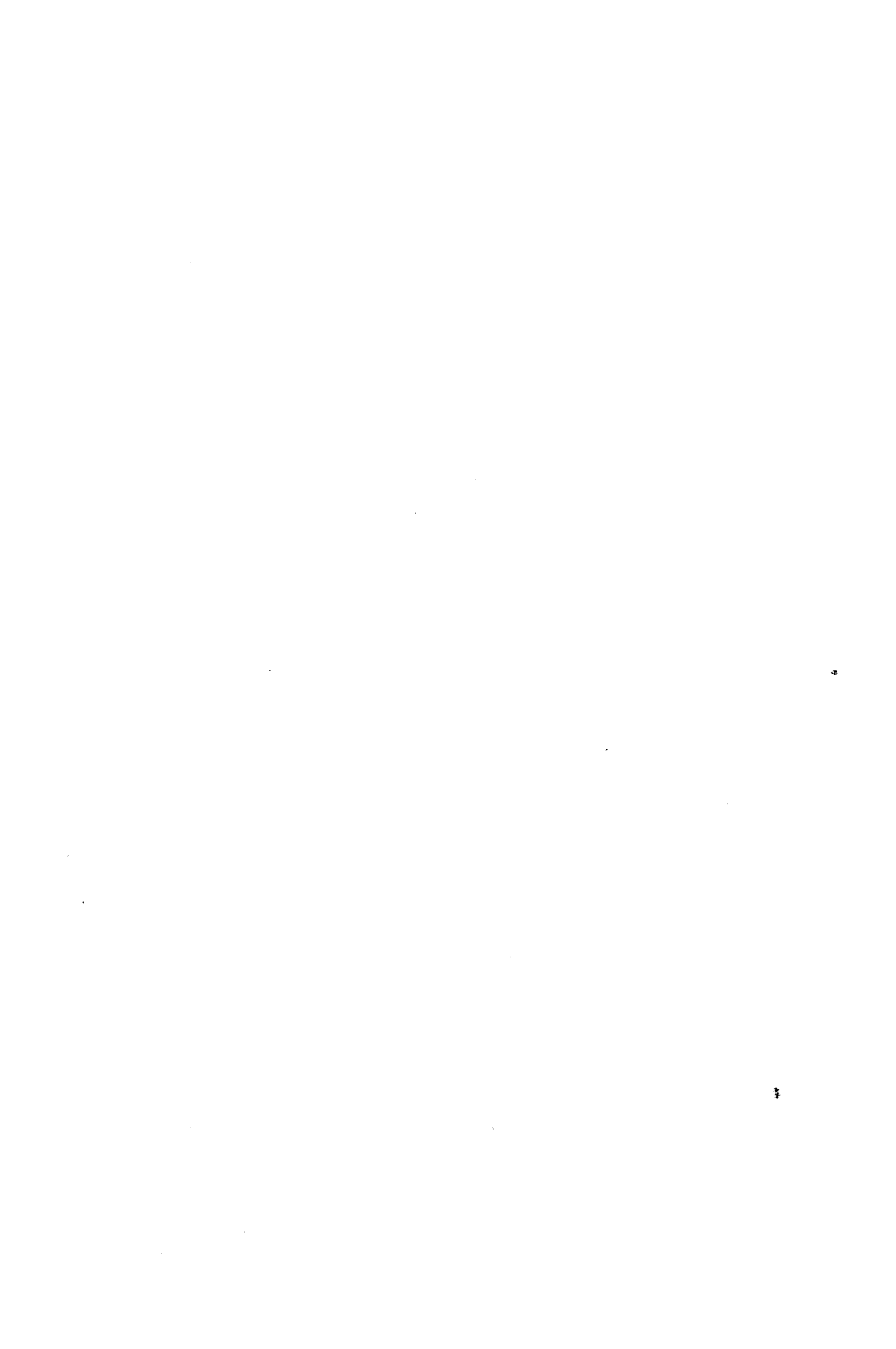

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish as provided in the gen-  
2 eral law for fishing in all of the tributaries to Webb's river,  
3 above Goodwin brothers' mill dam in Carthage, in the county  
4 of Franklin.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act  
2 are hereby repealed.
