
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to fishing in the tributaries of Webb's river, above Goodwin brothers' mill dam in Carthage, county of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish as provided in the gen-2 eral law for fishing in all of the tributaries to Webb's river, 3 above Goodwin brothers' mill dam in Carthage, in the county 4 of Franklin.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act 2 are hereby repealed.
