STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 6 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Probate Courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Section 6. During the sickness, absence from the State 4 or inability of any judge of probate to hold the regular terms 5 of his court, such terms, at his request or that of the register 6 of the county, may be held by the judge of any other county;

7 the judges may interchange services or perform each others'

8 duties when they find it necessary or convenient, and in case

9 of the death of a judge, all necessary terms of the probate

10 court for the county, may, at the request of the register, be

11 held by the judge of another county, until the vacancy is

12 filled. The orders, decrees and decisions of the judge hold-

13 ing such terms, have the same force and validity as if made

14 by the judge of the county in which such terms are held.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
