STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to increase the salary of the judge of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one of chapter six hundred and thirty-
- 2 six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 seventy-one, as since amended, entitled "An Act to establish
- 4 a municipal court in the city of Lewiston," is hereby further
- 5 amended by striking out the words "fifteen hundred" in the
- 6 eighth line of said section as amended, and inserting instead
- 7 the words 'two thousand,' so that said section as hereby
- 8 amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. A municipal court is hereby established for the 10 city of Lewiston, which shall be a court of record, and have

11 a seal, and shall consist of one judge, who shall be a member
12 of the bar in Androscoggin county, who shall be appointed,
13 elected, qualified, and hold his office as provided in the con14 stitution, who shall reside during his continuance in office in
15 said city of Lewiston, and who shall receive from said city in
16 monthly payments, an annual salary of two thousand dollars,
17 which shall be in full for all fees pertaining to his office.'
Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
