STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Winthrop to erect and maintain a wharf in Lake Maranocook, in the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Winthrop is hereby authorized to
2 raise by taxation such an amount of money as it may deem
3 necessary to erect, maintain and control a wharf at any point
4 on the southerly end of Lake Maranocook, and said town is
5 hereby authorized to erect, maintain and control a wharf
6 from any point of the shore on the southerly end of Lake
7 Maranocook.
