STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of chapter 241 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 entitled "An Act to supply the town of Lisbon with pure water."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges which were
2 granted to the town of Lisbon by chapter 241 of the Private
3 and Special Laws of the year 1903 are hereby extended for
4 and during the period of two years from the 24th day of
5 March, A. D. 1905, and all the rights, powers and privileges
6 that were granted by said act may and shall be exercised in
7 the same manner and for the same purpose as provided in
8 said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
