IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a highway and bridge  
across York river.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. A highway with a suitable bridge as a part  
2 thereof may be laid out, constructed and maintained in the  
3 manner provided in chapter twenty-three of the Revised  
4 Statutes, across the tide waters of York river in the town of  
5 York. Said way shall be located at some point between  
6 Varrell's wharf, so called, and the bridge of the York Har-  
7 bor and Beach Railroad Company; and shall extend over said  
8 river to Bragdon's island, so called; thence over and across  
9 said island to Harris's island, so called; thence over and

10 across said island, and over intervening lands and tide waters  
11 to the south side of said river, there to connect with such  
12 ways as common convenience and necessity may require.  
13 Any bridge so constructed shall have a draw sufficient and  
14 convenient for the passage of vessels navigating said river,  
15 with necessary piers and abutments, and shall be built in  
16 accordance with the acts of Congress pertaining to bridges  
17 and piers extending over and across navigable waters.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
