IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 26, Private and Special Laws of 1887 as amended by chapter 487 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897, relating to the taxation of certain plantations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter twenty-six of the Private 2 and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, as 3 amended by chapter four hundred and eighty-seven of the 4 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety- 5 seven, is hereby further amended by striking out all of that 6 part of said section which reads as follows, "Coplin, 79, 7 Franklin, 1, R. 3, W. B. K. P.; Dallas, 145, Franklin, 2, R. 2, 8 W. B. K. P.; Greenvale, 50, Franklin; Lang, 45, Franklin, 2,

9 Range 3, West Bingham's Kennebec Purchase; Perkins, 134,
10 Franklin; Rangeley, 64, Franklin, 3, R. I, W. B. K. P."

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
