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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section 65 of chapter 10 of the Revised  
Statutes relating to the collection of taxes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 65 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes  
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-  
3 ing: 'And no execution shall run against the body of any  
4 person issued on a judgment recovered for the collection of  
5 any poll tax,' so that said section as amended shall read as  
6 follows:

'In addition to other provisions for the collection of taxes  
8 legally assessed, the mayor and treasurer of any city, the  
9 selectmen of any town and the assessors of any plantation to  
10 which a tax is due may in writing direct an action of debt

11 to be commenced in the name of such city or of the inhab-  
12 itants of such town or plantation, against the party liable;  
13 but no such defendant is liable for any costs of suit, unless  
14 it appears by the declaration and by proof, that payment of  
15 said tax had been duly demanded before suit. And no execu-  
16 tion shall run against the body of any person issued on a  
17 judgment recovered for the collection of any poll tax.'
