STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to permit the Bridgton Street Railway Co. to discontinue the operation of its line during certain months of the year.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Bridgton Street Railway Co., a corporation
2 organized under the General Laws of the State of Maine,
3 chapter fifty-three (53) of the Revised Statutes and laws
4 relating thereto, for the purpose of operating its road by
5 electricity, compressed air or animal power, is hereby author-
6 ized and empowered to discontinue the operation of said road,
7 or any part thereof, from the 15th day of September to the
8 15th day of the following June, inclusive, or any part of said
9 period, in each year, when in the judgment of the directors of

10 said company its tracks are so obstructed by ice or snow, or
11 for any other cause, as to make its operation impracticable
12 or resulting in loss to said company.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
