HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the time of construction of the Boothbay
Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The time within which the Boothbay Railroad
2 Company may commence construction of its line is hereby
3 extended to March first, in the year nineteen hundred and
4 seven.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
