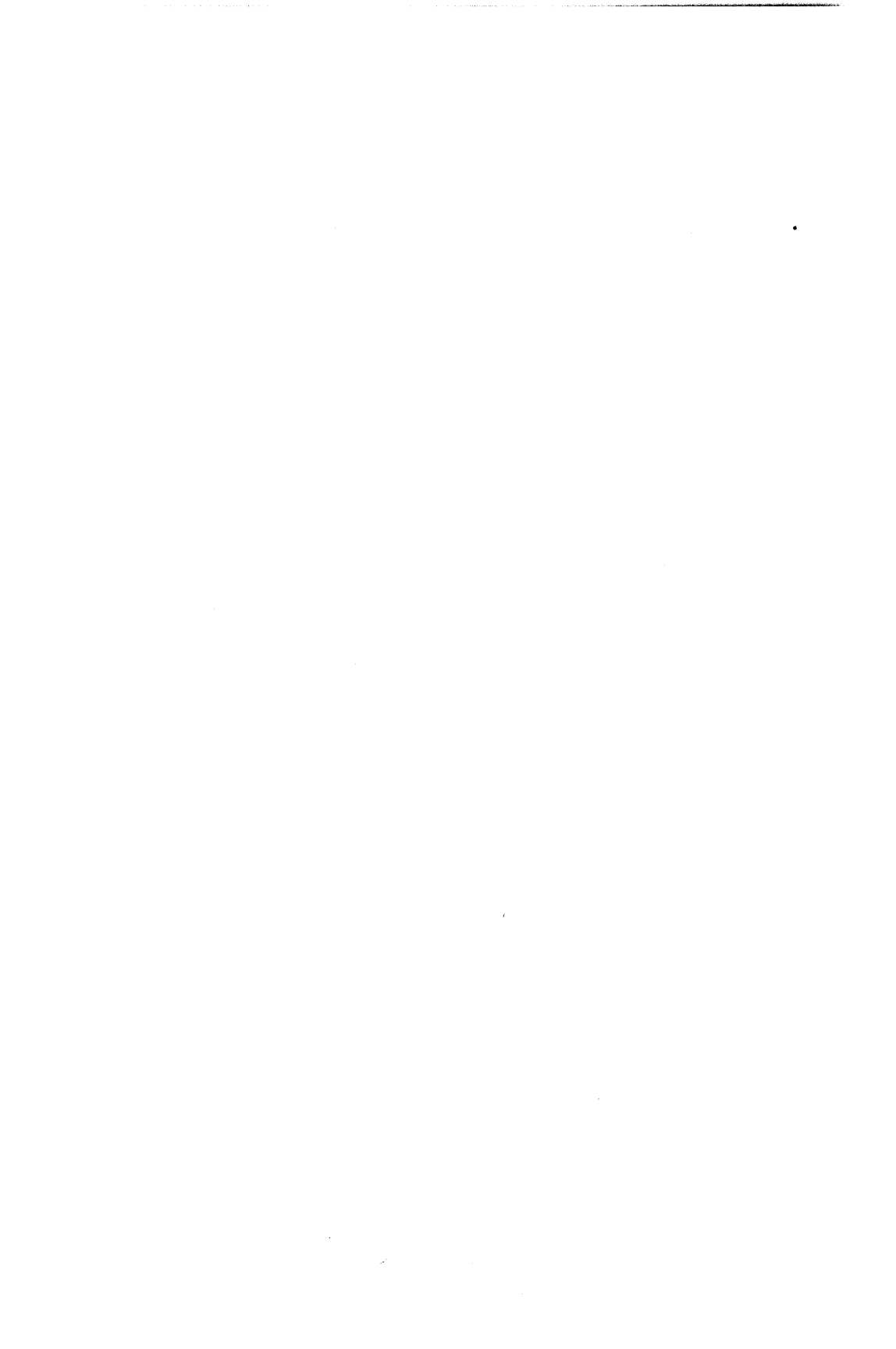
AN ACT relating to the Lincoln Electric Railway Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section I. Section eleven of chapter two hundred seventy-
2 one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
3 one, as amended by chapter sixty-three of the Private and
4 Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, is hereby
5 amended by striking out the word "four," in the third line,
6 and inserting in place thereof, the word 'six,' so that said
7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section II. This charter shall be null and void unless
9 operations for building this railroad shall have been actually
10 commenced within six years from the date of the passage of
11 this act.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
