STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Recorder of the Western Hancock Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. From and after the first day of January, 1905,
2 the salary of the recorder of the Western Hancock municipal
3 court shall be three hundred (300) dollars annually, payable
4 quarterly, by the county treasurer of said county of Hancock. Sect. 2. All fees received by him as recorder shall be paid
2 into the county treasury within thirty days after the receipt
3 thereof.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
