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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to change the name of Calf Island to Opechee Island.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The island known by the name of Calf island,  
2 being and lying in the limits of Swan's island, in the county  
3 of Hancock and State of Maine and bordering the northern  
4 side of York's Narrows and containing two hundred and  
5 fifty-six acres more or less, belonging to Colson H. Robbins  
6 of said Swan's island, is hereby changed to Opechee island.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
