## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to change the name of Calf Island to Opechee Island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The island known by the name of Calf island,

- 2 being and lying in the limits of Swan's island, in the county
- 3 of Hancock and State of Maine and bordering the northern
- 4 side of York's Narrows and containing two hundred and
- 5 fifty-six acres more or less, belonging to Colson H. Robbins
- 6 of said Swan's island, is hereby changed to Opechee island. Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
