
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend paragraph five of section 1 of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 relating to ice fishing in Pease pond, in Wilton, Franklin county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter 407 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1903 is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "Pease pond in Wilton, in which it shall be lawful to
4 fish through the ice, as provided in the general law, on Sat-
5 urdays of each week during the months of February, March
6 and April of each year, and" in the second, third, fourth and
7 fifth lines of paragraph five, entitled "In Franklin County,"
8 so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'In Franklin county. In all the ponds and lakes situated
10 wholly or partly in Franklin county, except Indian pond, situ-
11 ated partly in Franklin and partly in Somerset county, in
12 which last named pond it shall be lawful to fish through the
13 ice as provided in the general law.'
