IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in West Carry pond, in Somerset
County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish in West Carry pond, in the county of
3 Somerset, from October first until the ice is out of said lake
4 the following spring of each year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the gen-
3 eral law of the State for illegal fishing.
