AN ACT to extend the charter of the Phillips Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Phillips
2 Trust Company, which were granted by chapter three hun-
3 dred and twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of
4 nineteen hundred and three are hereby extended for two
5 years from the approval of this act; and the persons named
6 in said act, their associates and successors shall have all the
7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said
8 act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same
9 purposes as therein specified.
