STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Skowhegan to subscribe to
the capital stock of Skowhegan Hall Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Skowhegan is hereby authorized
2 to subscribe to the capital stock of the Skowhegan Hall Asso-
3 ciation to an amount not exceeding the sum of thirty thou-
4 sand dollars, and to make such arrangements as the corpora-
5 tion and the town may mutually agree upon, in relation to
6 the use and occupancy of such part of the building for town
7 purposes as may be convenient to the town.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by a
2 majority vote of the legal voters of the town of Skowhegan
3 at its annual town meeting in March in the year one thousand

4 nine hundred and five, or at a legally called town meeting to
5 be specially called and held for that purpose within ninety
6 days after the approval of this act.
