IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 10 of chapter 98 of the Revised
Statutes relating to replevin bond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Amend section 10 of chapter 98 of the Revised
2 Statutes by inserting after the word "sureties" in the third
3 line the words 'or a surety company authorized to do busi-
4 ness in this State'; also by inserting after the word "sureties"
5 in the fifth line the words 'or surety company,' so that said
6 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. Before serving the writ, the officer shall take
8 from the plaintiff, or someone in his behalf, a bond to the
9 defendant, with sufficient sureties or a surety company
10 authorized to do business in this State, in double the value of

11 the goods to be replevined, conditioned as in the prescribed
12 form of the writ, to be returned with the writ to the court
13 from which the writ issued, for the use of the defendant, and
14 new sureties or surety company may be required thereof as
15 provided in section three.'
