IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to increase the capital stock of the Skowhegan Hall
Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter four of Private and
2 Special Laws of 1866 is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the words "to the amount of" in the second line of said sec-
4 tion the words 'one hundred,' so that said section as amended
5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation may purchase and hold real and
7 personal estate to the amount of one hundred and twenty-
8 five thousand dollars and may erect and maintain a block in
9 Skowhegan village to be used for halls, stores and other pur-

10 poses, and may improve, rent, lease, sell, convey and transfer
11 the corporate property as may be necessary.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
