IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the rights, powers and privileges of the Brownville and Williamsburg Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the

- 2 Brownville and Williamsburg Water Company which were
- 3 granted by chapter 199 of the Private and Special Laws of
- 4 the year 1903, are hereby extended for and during the period
- 5 of two years from March 18, 1905, and all the rights, powers
- 6 and privileges that were granted by said act may and shall
- 7 be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes
- 8 as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
