IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 4 of chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes, relating to service upon co-partners in trustee process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4 of chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out the word "the" before 3 "place" in the seventh line and inserting in place thereof the 4 word 'any,' so that said section as amended shall read as 5 follows:

'Sect. 4. A like service on the trustee binds all goods, 7 effects or credits of the principal defendant entrusted to and 8 deposited in his possession, to respond to the final judgment 9 in the action, as when attached by ordinary process. When 10 a partnership is made a trustee in a trustee suit, service upon

11 one member of the firm shall be a sufficient attachment of the
12 property of the principal defendant in the possession of the
13 firm, provided, that such service be made at any place of
14 business of the firm, or that legal service be afterward made
15 upon the other members of the firm.'
