IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section ninety-seven of chapter fifteen of the
Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and three.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section ninety-seven of chapter fifteen of the
2 Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and three is hereby
3 amended by substituting for the word "five" before the word
4 "thousand" therein, the word 'seven,' so that said section
5 shall read:

'Section 97. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions
7 of the three preceding sections, there is hereby appropriated
8 the sum of seven thousand dollars annually which sum shall
9 be deducted and set aside therefor by the treasurer of State
10 from the annual school funds of the State.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

If any statement is necessary it may be simply stated thus: The number of unorganized townships in which schools should be established and maintained, as per sections 94, 95 and 96 of chapter 15, Revised Statutes 1903, has so increased as to require the sum mentioned in the accompanying act to defray the expenses thereof.
