RESOLVE in favor of the Farmington State Normal School.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum  
2 of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and  
3 five, and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred and six for laboratory, library room, assembly room,  
5 ceilings, basement, gymnasium, grounds, insurance, steam  
6 pump.

For the completion and repairs of the normal school building at Farmington there is needed for the

Laboratory .....	\$400
Library rooms .....	600
Book cases in the assembly room.....	300
Book cases in recitation rooms.....	150
Steel ceilings .....	600
Cementing basement and gymnasium floor.....	500
Grading .....	150
Insurance of boilers .....	100
Steam pump and repairs.....	200
Total .....	<u>\$3,000</u>
