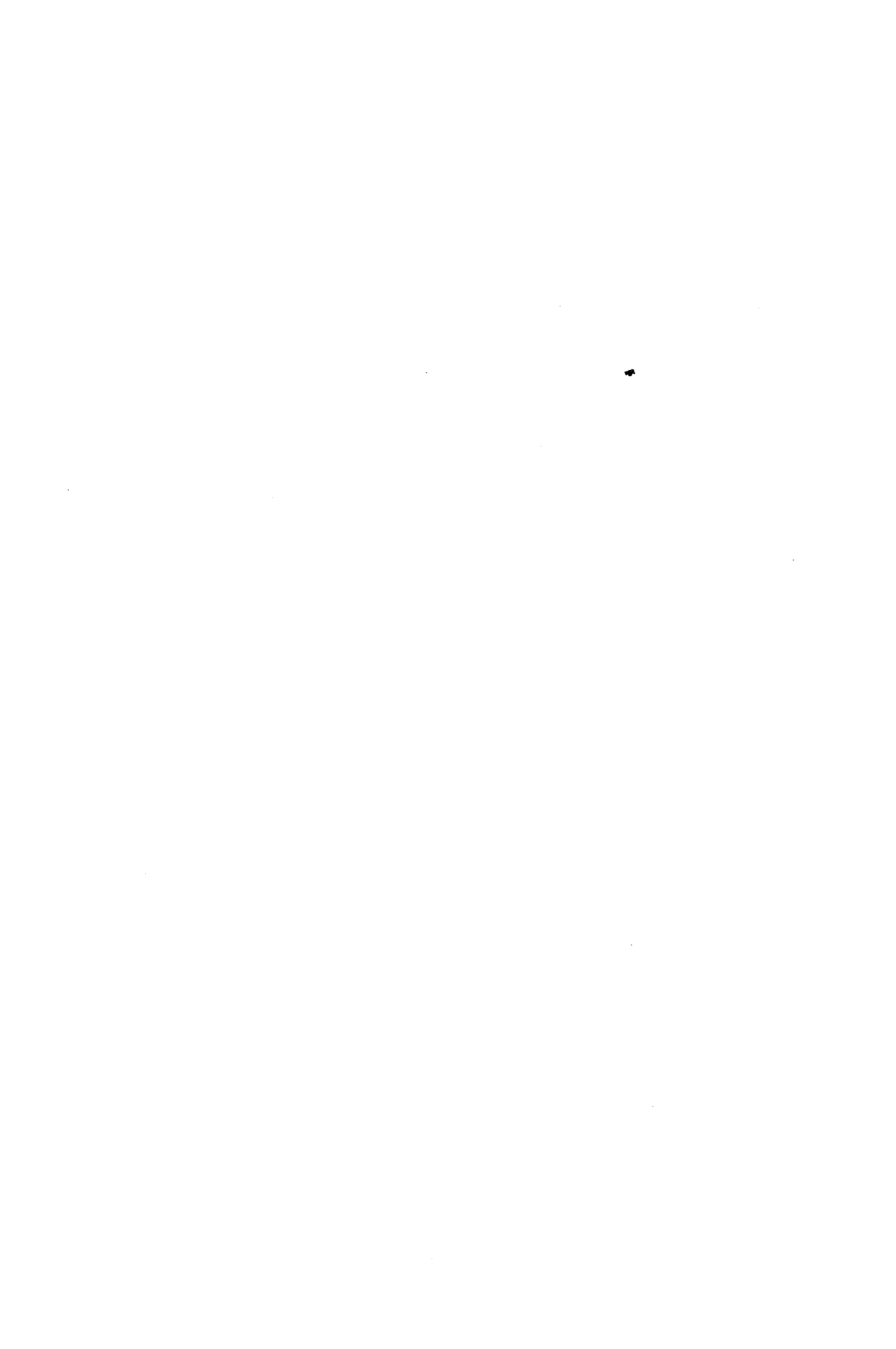
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the European and North American Railway and the Maine Central Railroad Company, its lessee, to change the location of its railroad bridge across the Kenduskeag stream in Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The European and North American Railway
2 and the Maine Central Railroad Company, its lessee, are
3 hereby authorized to change the location of the bridge of said
4 European and North American Railway across the Kendus-
5 keag stream in Bangor under the direction of the railroad
6 commissioners, and to build and maintain a new bridge, with
7 two or more tracks, and a sidewalk for foot passengers on
8 the north side thereof upon the changed location.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
